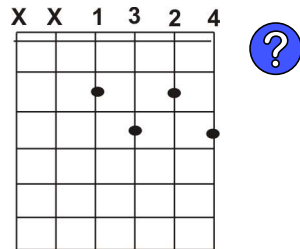

Diminished chords are an essential shapes to learn if you really want to spice up your Django rhythm. There are three main shapes to learn, the first being the high end sound. This can be easily played up and down the neck.
